NOTIFICATION

Online Applications are invited for admission to the Under Graduate Programmes in the affiliated colleges of University of Calicut for the academic year 2016-2017.

The following Courses are not included the Centralised Admission Process.

1. All Under Graduate Programmes with Entrance
2. Bachelor of Audiology and Speech Language Pathology
3. BSc Nursing
4. BSc Medical Laboratory Technology
5. BSc Medical Microbiology
6. BSc Medical Biochemisrtry
7. Bachelor of Physical Education
8. All Under Graduate Programme for which affiliation orders are issued after the closing date of admission.

Eligibility for Admission

Those candidates who are “Eligible for Higher Studies” as per the Higher Secondary Examination or a pass in the equivalent examination is the minimum criteria for admission to degree courses, unless otherwise specified.

All Candidates qualified in the annual examination held upto and including the preceding academic years are eligible for admission. However, candidates who have qualified the HSE and VHSE of the Government of Kerala under ‘SAY’ scheme and Compartmental Examination of CBSE are also eligible for admission to first year degree courses in the same academic year.

Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination of Tamil Nadu (Private study) shall not be admitted to any course under this University. (U.ONo.GAI/A1/5062/2002 dated 07.07.2005).



The Physically Challenged candidates are not eligible for admissions to the Geology course. The visually challenged candidates are not eligible for admission to science subjects involving practicals

All candidates seeking admission to the UG programmes irrespective of the Quota (General merit/reservation/sports/Persons with disabilities/Mentally Retarded /Community/Management/Kashmir Students/Students from Andaman & Nicobar Islands) should compulsorily register through ***Centralized Admission Process (CAP)***.

The candidates who have not registered **through CAP** will not be permitted to take admission at any stage of the admission process.

The ethnic natives of Lakshadweep seeking admissions need not register through CAP. The colleges shall admit them and forward the list to the University through e-mail. The University will generate CAP ID and intimate the respective colleges.

I. Admissions to Programmes which come under the purview of Centralised Admission Process:

A) Centralized Admission Process

Allotment to the seats under the merit/reservation quota is conducted through Centralised Admission process. Selection/allotment of a candidate to a particular programme to any college will be based on the rank of the candidate and the availability of the seat.

B) Details of seat that comes under the ambit of Centralized Admission Process (CAP)

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Candidates should go through the prospectus (Will be published on 10.05.2016) for Centralised Admission Process available in the website (www.cuonline.ac.in) carefully before entering the registration page.

II.Mode of Registration : Online

The Online registration will commence on **18.05.2016** onwards. The Online registration through **Centralised Admission Process** will be conducted in Single stage.

III.PAYMENT OF ONLINE REGISTRATION FEE

The fee payment for online registration can be remitted from 18.05.2016 onwards
Payment of fee for online registration can be made **only** through e-payment system (SBT online/Nodal Centers functioning in Affiliated colleges/Friends Janasevena kendram/Akshaya kendras).

For General category candidates : Rs 250/-

For SC/ST :Rs 100/-

“Application fee once remitted will not be refunded under any circumstances.”

IV.Indexing of Marks for ranking.

Candidates registering their options, should satisfy all the eligibility criteria with regard to the



academic qualifications prescribed in the admission rules. Eligibility criteria and rules for calculating index marks for admission to various courses will be published in the website (www.cuonline.ac.in) before commencement of registration.

V. Allotments

There will be Five allotments to **AIDED, GOVERNMENT COLLEGES** and **UN AIDED COLLEGES**. Thereafter, special allotments shall be conducted by the University after collecting the vacancy position in each category of seats from the colleges.

VI. Admissions.

a) Through Allotments

The candidates receiving allotments for the first options and those candidates who are satisfied with the allotment received in any of the allotments from **FIRST to THIRD** can take admissions to the respective colleges from the date of publication of the allotments to the last date of admissions earmarked after the third allotment.

Those candidates who receive an allotment and if satisfied with that allotment should cancel their higher options. In case the higher options are not cancelled the candidate will be considered for the higher options and will be bound to take admission to the allotment received for their higher options.

b) Permanent and Temporary Admissions

After Third allotments all candidates should take admissions in colleges allotted either on Permanent or Temporary basis.

b (1) Permanent Admission

All those who received allotment to their first option and candidates satisfied with their current allotment and **not willing** to be considered for higher options shall take permanent admission.

b (2) Temporary Admissions

All those who received allotment but not satisfied with their current allotment and **willing** to be considered for higher options shall take temporary admission after third and fourth allotments. These, candidates will be considered for their higher options.

c) Admissions to Management//Sports/Physically Handicapped/Mentally Retarded Seats/Kashmiri Students/Students from Andaman Nicobar Islands



c (1) Management Quota, Sports Quota, seats for Mentally Retarded, Students from Adaman Nicobar Islands and Kashmir

Candidates seeking admission to the above quotas in Government/Aided/Unaided colleges should register in CAP. In addition to this candidate should contact the colleges he/she intends to take admissions and submit separate applications in the colleges concerned.

c(2) Community Quota and Physically Handicapped Seats

The candidates seeking admission to the community quota in aided colleges should register in CAP. University will prepare a list of such candidates and the colleges will admit the candidates based on the merit from this list. The University has earmarked July 4th 2016 to July 8th 2016 for admission to community quota. The colleges can announce a convenient date between these dates by publishing in the college notice board as well as through press release.

The community list will be published in the college login and website by the University. The colleges shall publish the community ranklist in the college notice board also.

VII. Compulsory Admissions

After the Fifth and final allotment the candidates should take admission compulsorily by cancelling their higher options. Further, if any vacancies exist the University will conduct special allotments.

VIII. Mandatory fee

Those who have obtained allotment will have to remit the prescribed **Mandatory Fee** due to the University through e-payment within the time prescribed to claim the allotment. The candidate failing to do so will lose his/her current allotment and he/she will be expelled from further allotments. The details of the mandatory fee will be published in the website before the first allotment.

VIII. Nodal Centers

Nodal Centers are functioning in all affiliated colleges in connection with the online registration to UG programmes 2016. In each nodal center a nodal officer has been appointed and the students can avail their assistance for registration. The list of Nodal centers are published in the website. The candidates can identify the nearest nodal center from the list and approach such centers for assistance.

XI. Editing of the Data entered at the time of registration.



The candidates can edit the data entered including photo till the **FINAL SUBMISSION** is done. After **FINAL SUBMISSION** the data can only be edited by the Nodal Centers functioning in the affiliated colleges. The list of Nodal centers are published in the website. The candidates intending to edit the details after final submission can identify the nearest nodal center from the list and approach such center for assistance.
